

Carmarthen Motor Club Road Rally Championship 2023 Rules

1. All entrants must be paid members of Carmarthen Motor Club
2. Six road rally results, will be used to accolade the points, these events are free to the competitor to choose.
3. Points will be awarded on the following basis:
 - 5 Points for Start
 - 5 Points for Finish
 - 10 points for a class win, descending to 1 point for 10th in class

(For this purpose an overall win will be looked at as 1st in class, on this basis a competitor, competing in an expert class is capable of a maximum of 20 points on an event, as is a novice competing at the lower end of the spectrum).
4. It will be the competitors responsibility to verify his results and claim points by notifying the appropriate co-ordinator, and this must be done within ten (10) days of the result. Once claimed they cannot be replaced by a better result at a later date, hence it is the competitors gamble to drop events and not claim scores because they think it was a poor result, and it also levels the playing field for the lower budgeted crews who only plan on a limited number of events.
5. For this year only a dispensation of 10 day rule will be in place until the 31st of March 2023, purely due to the late implementation of the championship, and bearing in mind some club members have already done some events this year.
6. In the event of a tie-break, highest scores per event will be used, in descending order.
