## FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for your entry and we hope that you have an enjoyable day's sport.

Your provisional start time will be shown on the Notice Board. **Actual due times at MC1 will be indicated on your time-card nr 1 issued at signing-on.**

**Cross Cars will run first on the road**

Please note the following amendments to the regulations:

3. Motorsport UK Permit Number: 200846

Motorsport UK Cross Cars Permit Number: Permit number 200846 includes a certificate of exemption for the Cross Cars

5. Scrutineering and signing-on will take place at The Welsh Motorsport Centre at Pembrey at the following times

Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> December 2024 between 15.00 – 17.00

Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> December 2024 between 06.00 and 08.00

### **Competitors should be aware of the following:**

Hi-viz side window numbers are to be fitted and black numbers to be fitted to the bottom of the rear screen (or equivalent space on two-seater cars) as per **R6.1.3(b)** and will be provided by the organisers.

Door competition numbers are to be provided by competitors. Rally Marketing will be selling these at Pembrey on Sunday morning.

**BARC Pembrey will be using e-tickets for admission to the circuit. In accordance with SR28, you will be issued with 6 nr personnel e-tickets per day via email to your nominated team e-mail address. These are for the driver, co-driver and up to 4 other support personnel. It will be the competitor's responsibility to distribute these to team members as appropriate. The competitor and team are responsible for either printing the tickets off prior to travelling, or to produce them at the admission gate on a smartphone.**

Access to the service will be the same as for recent events. After passing through the personnel pass check at the main gate, **competitors should bear right in front of the Medical Centre** (via the main crossroads) to cross the circuit at the Formula One Bar. This will be arrowed for those unfamiliar with the venue.

Scrutineering, noise and signing on will take place within the paddock area at the Welsh Motorsport Centre at Pembrey. On arrival please follow the one-way route as shown on the attached map to the noise test (located near the control tower) where you will receive your process

card. On successful completion of the noise test, proceed to scrutineering (within the scrutineering bays) and then signing-on (at Race Control - near to the scrutineering bays).

Noise, scrutineering and signing will be open from 15.00 to 17.00 on Saturday evening, and from 06.00 to 08.00 on Sunday morning. No vehicles will be admitted into the paddock area after 08.30 on Sunday morning.

We would like to encourage as many crews as possible to carry out scrutineering etc on the Saturday afternoon, and any crews who did not indicate a preference are still welcome to turn up between 15.00 and 17.00 on Saturday.

Driver's briefings are now a mandatory requirement from the Motorsport UK. A briefing will be held in the vicinity of Signing-on/Scrutiny (depending on weather) at 08.30. **All crews are required to attend.**

Overnight parking is permitted at Pembrey by prior arrangement, but it is unlikely that the bar will be open. If you wish to utilise this agreement please send an email to [cmcentry@aol.com](mailto:cmcentry@aol.com) and we will confirm with the venue.

Your particular attention is drawn to the Motorsport UK's published requirements for Health & Safety in Service Areas. Please ensure that you familiarise yourselves with these requirements **prior to the event**. Particular attention is drawn to regulation 25.

**25. REFUELLING** *All competitors shall familiarise themselves with the recommendations published by Motorsport UK with regard to the refuelling of competing vehicles on the event. A refuelling zone has been set up near to the service area for this purpose and it is mandatory that competitors make use of this facility. **BOTH CREW MEMBERS MUST BE OUT OF THE CAR WHILST REFUELLING TAKES PLACE. NO REFUELLING TO BE CARRIED OUT OTHER THAN WITHIN THE DESIGNATED REFUELLING AREA.***

Please also remember that **dogs are not permitted within the venue (even if they are in vehicles!!)**. Anyone with dogs will be asked to leave by the circuit management – and this policy is strictly enforced by them.
